**SUMMARY:**

This bill amends the investments of reserves exceeding current requirements to allow ASGERF to invest monies locally without unnecessary restrictions.

4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING THE  
5 INVESTMENTS OF RESERVES EXCEEDING CURRENT REQUIREMENTS  
6 TO ALLOW ASGERF TO INVEST IN MONIES LOCALLY WITHOUT  
7 UNNECESSARY RESTRICTIONS; AMENDING SECTION 7.1444, A.S.C.A."

8  
9 Preamble:

10 WHEREAS, the American Samoa Government Employees Retirement Fund  
11 ("ASGERF") is underfunded. This means that the current assets and  
12 projected future contributions are not sufficient to meet the expected  
13 future benefit obligations to retirees. This situation poses a  
14 considerable financial risk, as it could result in the depletion of the  
15 Fund's resources, jeopardizing the retirement security of current and  
16 future beneficiaries; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, the unfunded liability aspect of the fund is the gap between what we  
19 need to pay in the future and what we have saved up today.  
20 Addressing this unfunded liability is crucial to ensure the Fund's long-  
21 term sustainability and fulfill the commitments made to our public  
22 servants. Without adequate measures, such as increasing our  
23 contributions and allowing more flexible investment strategies,  
24 ASGERF will struggle to maintain its solvency and meet its  
25 obligations, ultimately affecting the financial stability and well-being  
26 of the community; and

27  
28 WHEREAS, ASGERF requires greater flexibility to invest funds in local  
29 infrastructure to alleviate some unfunded liability. Repealing ASCA

1 §7.1444(g) will allow ASGERF to invest locally without unnecessary  
2 restrictions, thereby increasing potential revenue streams. Local  
3 investments can boost economic activities, create jobs, and generate  
4 additional income for the Fund. This approach helps raise revenues  
5 and supports the growth of our local economy. Furthermore, these  
6 investments can lead to improved infrastructure, better services and  
7 enhanced quality of life for residents of American Samoa; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, American Samoa needs to take control of its economic growth.  
10 Investing in local infrastructure is innovative, responsible, and  
11 necessary for future development. We can significantly raise  
12 revenues and reduce the ASGERF's unfunded liability by deleting the  
13 cap on local investments. This strategic move ensures the Fund's long-  
14 term sustainability, providing financial security for current and future  
15 retirees. Additionally, it fosters self-reliance and resilience within our  
16 community, positioning American Samoa for sustained economic  
17 prosperity. By empowering ASGERF to make prudent local  
18 investments, we are investing in the future of our people and the  
19 strength of our economy.  
20

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF AMERICAN SAMOA  
22

23 Section 1. 7.1444 is amended to read:

24 “7.1444 Investment of reserves exceeding current requirements.

25 (a) The reserves of the Fund in excess of requirements for current operations  
26 shall be invested and reinvested by or under authority of the Board of Trustees. At  
27 its discretion, the Board may designate one or more of its members to supervise this  
28 function; in either case, references to the Board in this section are considered to  
29 refer to the individual or committee exercising the function.

1           (b) The Board of Trustees has full power and authority to direct the  
2 investment and reinvestment of the fund without distinction between principal and  
3 income, in property (defined in (c) below) it considers advisable. The Board may  
4 invest and reinvest the fund in property in which a prudent man familiar with those  
5 matters and using care, skill, prudence, and diligence enterprise would invest in the  
6 conduct of like character and with like aims, ensuring that the investments of the  
7 fund are diversified so as to minimize the risk of large losses unless to do so would  
8 clearly not be prudent. The power to manage investments includes, but is not  
9 limited to, the power to hold, purchase, sell, convey, assign, transfer, dispose of,  
10 lease, subdivide, or partition any assets held or proceeds thereof, to execute or cause  
11 to be executed relevant documents; to enter into protective agreements, execute  
12 proxies, grant consent; and to do all other things necessary or appropriate to its  
13 position as an owner or creditor.

14           (c) The word “property” means and includes real, personal, and mixed  
15 property of any and every kind and nature, including but not limited to, bonds,  
16 preferred or common stocks, mortgages, interests in any kind of investment trust or  
17 common trust fund, notes, leases, oil or gas royalties, or other evidence of rights,  
18 interests or obligations, secured or unsecured, and whether or not they are of a  
19 wasting asset nature.

20           (d) All proceeds and income from investments, of whatever nature, must be  
21 credited to the account of the Fund. Transactions in marketable securities are  
22 carried out at prevailing market prices.

23           (e) Investments may be held in bearer form, or may be registered either in  
24 the name of the fund or the nominee of the custodian.

25           (f) Due bills may be accepted from brokers against payment for securities  
26 purchased, pending delivery within a reasonable period of time of certificates  
27 representing the investments.

28           ~~(g) Investments may not be made if, after the investment, the fund would~~  
29 own:

1           ~~(1) any combination of obligations of any one political subdivision,~~  
2 ~~corporation, or other single issuing entity in excess of 5 percent of Fund assets at~~  
3 ~~cost. This paragraph does not apply to general obligations of the United States or~~  
4 ~~the Dominion of Canada or of the government; or~~

5           ~~(2) obligations of the Dominion of Canada, together with its political~~  
6 ~~subdivisions and corporations organized under its law or the law of its provinces in~~  
7 ~~excess of 10 percent of fund assets at cost; or~~

8           ~~(3) obligations or other investments issued or guaranteed by the government~~  
9 ~~in excess of 17.5 percent of Fund assets at cost; provided, however, that this~~  
10 ~~limitation does not apply to the obligations or other investments that are~~  
11 ~~unconditionally guaranteed as to principal and interest by, or supported by lease~~  
12 ~~assignment from, another entity whose principal business is outside of American~~  
13 ~~Samoa.~~

14           (h)(g) The Board may engage one or more financial institutions as  
15 custodians to assume responsibility for the physical possession of Fund assets or  
16 evidences of assets. The custodian submits reports, accountings, and other  
17 information in a form and at such times as requested by the Board. All costs  
18 incurred for custodial services are paid by the Fund. The custodian holds all assets  
19 for the account of the Fund and acts only upon instructions of the Board.  
20 Custodians may not be engaged unless they:

21           (1) have been continuously engaged in rendering pension trust investment  
22 services for a period of 10 or more years; and

23           (2) are organized under the laws of the United States, a state, or a territory;  
24 and

25           (3) are custodians for not less than 20 corporate, municipal or governmental  
26 retirement funds with total assets of not less than \$30,000,000.

27           (i) (h) In order to secure expert advice and counsel, the Board may engage  
28 an investment agent who is an investment counselor as qualified by this subsection.  
29 The custodian may be engaged as the investment agent. All costs incurred in this

1 connection are paid by the fund. Persons, firms, or corporations may not be eligible  
2 for employment as investment agent which acts as principal for its own account or  
3 as a broker for a client other than the fund in connection with the sale of any  
4 security to or the purchase of any security from the Fund. Investment agents may  
5 not be engaged unless:

6 (1) the principal business of the person, firm, or corporation selected by the  
7 Board consists of rendering investment supervisory services; i.e., the giving of  
8 continuing advice concerning the investment of funds on the basis of the individual  
9 needs of each client;

10 (2) the principal control of the person, firm, or corporation rests with  
11 individuals who are actively engaged in the business;

12 (3) the person, firm, or corporation and its predecessors have been  
13 continuously engaged in the business for a period of 10 years or more years;

14 (4) the person, firm, or corporation is registered as an investment advisor  
15 under United States law;

16 (5) the contract between the Board and the investment agent is of no specific  
17 duration and is voidable at any time by either party; and

18 (6) the person, firm, or corporation certifies, in writing, to the Board, that the  
19 assets under its direct investment supervision are in excess of \$30,000,000. The  
20 Board establishes and may from time to time change operating arrangements with  
21 the investment agent in order to facilitate efficient management and timely-  
22 investment action. Investment may not be made unless in the opinion of the  
23 investment agent it is an appropriate investment for the Fund and is an authorized  
24 investment, or in the absence of that opinion, unless preceded by a resolution of the  
25 Board directing the investment.”
